


## FAQ: 'How do I enrol in a learning module'

To enrol in a module:


1. Log in to the [National Hand Hygiene Initiative \(NHHI\) Learning Management System \(LMS\)](#)





Healthcare workers (clinical and non-clinical) and healthcare students.


